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Other Requirements

1. Minimum 40 hours of upper division courses
2. Minimum 60 hours at a four-year institution
3. Minimum 30 degree-applicable credit hours completed at OSU
4. Minimum of 15 of the final 30 or 50% of the in the major field completed at OSU
5. Limit of one-half of major course requirements as transfer work; one-fourth of hours earned by correspondence; 8 transfer correspondence hours
6. Students will be held responsible for degree requirements in effect at the time of matriculation and any changes that are made, so long as these changes do not result in semester credit hours being added or do not delay graduation.
7. Degrees that follow this Academic Year 2021-2022 plan must be completed by the end of Summer 2027.
